#### **Comprehension**

It is said that you can use all 5 senses in a Havdalah service. Look at the blessings above and determine which senses go with which blessings (some may have multiples or none at all). Write your answers here.

Ritual objects are regular items that we use to do holy acts, like say blessings and celebrate holidays. What is a regular item in your life, that you use on an almost daily basis, that you could make holy? How can you turn a normal object into a ritual object?

What does it mean that we sing for Elijah the prophet to "come to us heralding redemption?" What is redemption?

It is said that we are Elijah's (and God's) partners in bringing redemption. We do this through Tikkun Olam (repairing the world). What is something you can do each week to help repair the world? Write or draw your answer below.

We begin Shabbat with Kiddush over the juice/wine and end Shabbat with the same blessing during Havdalah. Why do you think we do that?

#### **Vocabulary**

הַרְדָלָל means 'separation.' In the fourth blessing above, what are all the things we bless God for separating? Which separation do you think is most significant?

What is one more separation in your daily life for which you would bless God?

In the third blessing, we bless God as ビネディ いっかう Creator of the lights of fire. Why do you think it is plural, lights of fire, instead of just light of fire? What implication do you think that has in the Havdalah ceremony?
