Holy, Holy, Holy is the Adonai Tz'vaot; God's presence fills the whole earth!

Blessed is the presence of God, shining forth from where God dwells.

God alone is our god and our Creator, our Ruler and our Helper: and in mercy, God is revealed in the sight of all the living: I am Adonai your God.

Adonai shall reign forever, your God, O Zion, from generation to generation, Hallelujah!

To all generations we will declare Your greatness, and for all eternity proclaim Your holiness. Your praise, O God, shall never depart from our lips.

Blessed are you, Adonai, the Holy God.

Comprehension

This prayer needs to be said with a **מִנְיָן** (*minyan*), a group of 10 people. Why do you think this prayer needs a *minyan*? What about this prayer makes it more meaningful when it is said with a group instead of individually?

The last paragraph of this prayer begins with the words **לְדוֹר וָדוֹר**, from generation to generation. What are important things you have learned from other generations in your family? From parents? Grandparents? Great-Grandparents?

We go up on our tip toes on each word when we say **קָדוֹשׁ , קָדוֹשׁ , קָדוֹשׁ**, Holy, Holy Holy. Why do you think we do that? Why do we do it on that word?
